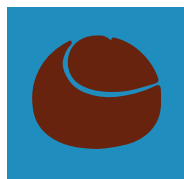

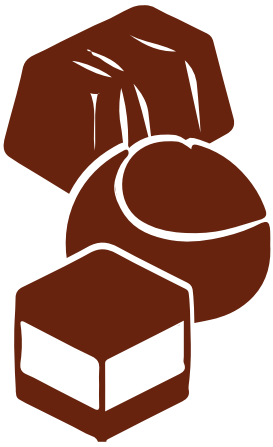
Live music throughout the Village. Art from Claremont Unified School District students will also be on display in galleries in partnership with Village Art Walk.
